OFFSEASON WORKOUTS FOR NON FALL SPORT ATHLETES BEGINNING JAN 7 TO FEB 13TH AT THE BIRM

League teams will play 12-14 games on week nights only (7-8 total nights). We will field a travel team that will be competing in tournaments around the state adding another 20-24 games. Level will be decided when commitments are received from all high school players on December 1st.

JH USSSA 13/14 Teams

There will be a player/parent meeting Feb. 18 at 5:00 in Coach Ledl's Room to provide all information for the upcoming spring/summer season. We will provide schedules, uniforms, and other information at this time. We will also hold a two-day minicamp (Feb 19-21) for all of our JH players at the Birm in Fordland for both the 13 and under and 14 and under teams. Cost will be 5 dollars per day for use of the indoor facility. This mini-camp will be ran by the high school coaches along with our two new junior high coaches. Practices will begin that following weekend with Coach Bond and Coach McDaniel.

Elem/Jr. High Baseball Camp

Baseball camp for 3-8 grades will take place Tue/Wed March 12th/13th during Spring Break at the baseball field. The camp cost is 25.00 but includes a t-shirt and instruction from Wildcat coaches and players. Sign up forms are located on the website and at the elementary and junior high in Feb.

Wildcat Hats/ Pullovers/Hoodies/Cage Jackets

Jerseys/Hats/Pullovers will go on sale on Jan 14th. Players will purchase their hats, pullover (if they don't have one already), and optional jackets. Parents and students can order as well. Payment and orders will be due by February 9th with order form attached. You can purchase hats (25.00), pullovers (35.00), BP Jackets (35.00), Hoodies (40.00). Payment will be due at time of order. Contact Coach Ledl for an order form. You can also find one on the website but it must be sent to Coach Ledl with money at the high school. Arrival date is usually around the weekend of Spring Break.



2018 RAFFLE

All players (High School and Junior High) who are on a summer roster will be required to participate in a summer raffle to raise money for the program. This will be in addition to their player's fee and is not optional. Players will be responsible for raising 75.00 for the program. After that amount has been reached, additional raffle money sold will be applied towards player fees. (Ex. 150.00 raffle sold would equate to 50 off player fees) This year's package will include a Missouri Pro Sports Package consisting of tickets to the Cardinals, Royals, and Springfield Cards.

2018 SPONSORSHIPS

Another great way to offset player fees will be the addition of sponsorships for individual players in the program. Sponsorship packages for local and area businesses are listed under the RBI tab on the website. New packages for Outfield signs and additional scoreboard signs will be available for 2018. This is not a donation. We would to give local businesses legitimate advertising venues at our games and tournaments. Players will be able to raise money through sponsorships to offset the cost of their summer fees for camps or tournaments at a 50% to 50% split. (Ex. Business A buys 450.00 advertising package. 225.00 would come off a player's fee with 225.00 going to the program)

SUMMER TEAM UNIFORMS/GEAR

9-12 Graders in our summer programs will wear their school ball hats and pants. Jerseys will be provided. 6-8 Graders will receive hats, jerseys, and will wear their own plain gray pants.
