#### 2024 SUMMER TEAMS

We will be fielding a Varsity League Team, and a JV League Team. All players will participate w/these teams during week nights. One of our agreements with local travel teams. League teams will play 12-14 games on week nights (usually on Tue) for a total of 7-8 total nights. We will field a travel team that will be competing in tournaments around the state adding another 20-24 games in. This is optional but highly encouraged if are not on another travel team. Levels will be decided when commitments are received from all high school players on December 1st.

#### JH USSSA 12/13/14 TEAMS

There will be a player/parent meeting Feb. 20 at 5:00 in Coach Ledl's Room to provide all information for the upcoming spring/summer season. We will provide schedules, uniforms, and other information at this time.
